Financial Assistance Program

- Awarded 20 family building grants and 41 fertility preservation grants.
- Shared program data via a scientific poster presented at an international conference.
- Blood and breast cancer patients make up 50%+ of grant recipients.
- Built and maintained referral relationships with 209 oncology nonprofits, adult and pediatric oncology social workers, nurse navigators, cancer centers and fertility centers around the U.S.

Advocacy Program

- Selected to attend ASCO's Annual Meeting as patient advocates.
- Participated at the Oncofertility Consortium Conference as advocates.
- Represented the patient voice at two ASCO and FDA Oncofertility events.

Education Program
